International Conference on Dublin Core and Metadata Applications

Program – Call for Papers

Conferences in the "Dublin Core" series cover standards and technologies related to metadata. Metadata - structured descriptions of people or resources such as books, documents, or products, whether on the Internet or in databases - is a key topic of information management. The use and sharing of metadata improves the quality of search and of access to information generally. This year's conference focuses on the use of metadata in applications of social computing and Semantic Web.

German- and English-language tutorials and introductory seminars will be held on the days before and after the main conference event. The conference itself will feature paper presentations, workshops, and poster sessions. The Dublin Core Metadata Initiative (DCMI) will hold meetings of various interest groups (such as Libraries and Government) and on a variety of metadata-related topics such as software tools, long-term archiving, and metadata for education.

Call for Papers through 13 April 2008

Scholarly papers, project reports, and poster proposals may be submitted for consideration through 13 April 2008. Posters will be presented for discussion in special sessions and remain on view for the duration of the conference.

An international program committee of metadata researchers and experts (chaired by Jane Greenberg, University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill and Wolfgang Klas, University of Vienna) will make a selection on the basis of peer review.
